### ELECTORS OF BREAN ADDRESS THE COUNCIL

### RADIOLINK

The Chairman welcomed IAN KENNETT who provided the background and benefits of the proposed change to the Radiolink service.

The Parish Council expressed concern that they had not been consulted on the change and that site owners who had their own radio system would need to carry two radios.

Ian Kennett undertook to clarify the situation and the operation of the system specifically for Brean users

### VEHICLE RECOGNITION CAMERA

Ian Kennett advised that it would be possible to install a camera in Brean to monitor vehicles entering and to highlight known "problem" vehicles to initiate police response.

The cost of this camera was stated to be in the region of £15K

Whilst this was agreed to be an excellent facility the problem of funding was the issue.

Cllr Harris agreed to raise this with the TOURISM ASSOCIATION and Cllr Grimes agreed to investigate sources of funding within Sedgemoor.
